Friday March 15th

Students will go to school on Friday, bring their overnight bag/luggage with them, and drop bags off in the band room before first period. Students will eat lunch at school then report to the band room for Dolphin Time. During Dolphin Time students will load the trailer, van, and then depart for Pennsylvania. We will make stops along the way for bathroom breaks and dinner. (each student will be given \$15 for a rest stop dinner). Students will arrive at the hotel about 7pm, check into the hotel, have a little free time, and go to bed early.

Saturday March 16th

Breakfast at hotel. This is the first day of competition where students will be competing in the “Prelims”. The performance schedule will be released later in the winter. We will most likely perform in the morning or early afternoon. After students perform they eat lunch at the HS (each student will be given \$15 for concessions) and they will stay and watch other groups perform. In the later afternoon students will go back to the hotel and enjoy pizza, the indoor pool, and free time.

Option 1: If the students make it out of prelims on Saturday they will go back to Liberty HS and perform in the finals. Awards are at 5pm. After awards they will drive back to Cape Cod. Lunch will be at the HS (each student will be given \$15 for concessions). Students will make a stop for dinner on the way home (each student will be given \$15 for a rest stop dinner). Students will return to DY about 1am.

Option 2: If the students do not make it out of prelims on Saturday the students will drive home after they check out of the hotel. Students will make a stop for lunch on the way home (each student will be given \$15 for a rest stop dinner). They will arrive back at DY about 4pm.
